Collezione 50 Vino Rosso, Cantina San Marzano, NV, Italy. Owners favourite!

Ruby red colour with purple reflections, intense and complex bouquet with fruity notes of prune, red jam, the spicy scent of vanilla and liquorice. Intense on the palate, full bodied and soft with a long finish.

Chateau Leydet – Valentin, Saint Emilion Grand Cru 2014 (just one bottle)

Nice restraint on the nose. Some black fruit, some chocolatey sweetness, plum and tobacco.

Very good palate. Immediately attractive on the attack, with a direct, almost red fruit freshness. Then it really opens up nicely in the mouth. Some leathery notes and texture. There's also a nice savoury feel over the fruit.

Fresh green apple, lime and passion fruit, this wine is zippy and delicious.

Sharpham Sparkling Blanc

This sparkling wine has been produced using the traditional method with whole berry pressing and a minimum of nine months ageing on the lees in the bottle. Full of fresh ripe fruit with superb citrus flavours, complimented by a fantastic balanced acidity.

20. Famille Lieubeau, Muscadet Sevre Et Maine Generations

Delicate flavours of apple and citrus fruits, the wine is left on its lees, during which time the wine acquires some complexity.

The composition of the soil, kimmeridgion, gives Chablis wines all its typicity. A beautiful organic wine.

29. Coral do Mar Albariño Pazo do Mar, Rías Baixas, Spain 2014

Fresh flavours of tropical fruit and white flowers with a fennel and salty finish. Classic zesty Albariño

31. Sauvignon Blanc, Allan Scott Family Winemakers, Marlborough

Fresh crisp & juicy herbed bouquet, with flavours of ripe tropical & citrus fruit, key lime & ruby grapefruit. The very essence of Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc.

A character of red apples & summer apples from the Pinot Gris, zesty, limey fruit & bracing acidity from the riesling. Finally aromatic spices, jasmine, rose petals from the Gewurztraminer.

33. Waters Edge Pinot Grigio

With rich soils and a temperate climate, Moldovan wines are perfect for all year consumption. This pinot grigio is lighter than its Italian cousin but, still has the citrus and fresh apple aroma that is distinctly recognisable.

34. Quinta da Lixa Flowers Vinho Verde.

Fruity, floral notes, fresh & well balanced. White peach, apples & tangerine on the palate leading to a long, crisp finish. Slight sparkle to the taste. Perfect for lunch.

35. Chateau Ste. Michelle Columbia Valley Riesling

Not a German Reisling something altogether different. Light yet concentrated with peach, zesty lemon & lime, apricot & mandarin flavours. It's aromatic but importantly dry.

36. #Lou by Peyrassol Rose, Cotes de Provence

Intense fruit flavours of gooseberry, fresh strawberry & white wine fruits. Simple, balanced & beautifully light. The artwork on the bottle is stunning. An interesting vineyard.

38. Sancerre Rose, Domaine de la Villaudiere, France

From the Pinot Noir, this wine with salmon-pink highlights gives fruity, freshness, harmony and elegance on the palate.

France

60. Domaine La Colombette Pinot Noir, France;

This strawberry scented stunner from the Colombette estate has taken years of dedication by the Pugibet family to providing a lighter style of Pinot Noir that is refreshing, yet maintains and concentrates the wines fruit flavour, supple and smooth.

61. Fleurie, Château de Fleurie, Beaujolais, France

From the domaine of an 18th century chateau, aged in a stunning vaulted cellar in oak vats using a process designed to extract more body during vinification. Has an intense garnet red colour with aromas of flowers and fruits such as ripe cherry and blackcurrant with a round, fleshy and elegant mouth.

63. Châteauneuf du Pape, 38 Parcelles, France

An intense rich and concentrate red, with a pepper edge and earthy nose.

64. Nuits St Georges, Chateai Gris 1st Cru Monopole, Albert Bichot, France

The nose is elegant and offers power, a beautiful finesse of the grain, a beautiful precision as well as intensity (justly controlled) and subtlety. It reveals notes of cassis, raspberry, small notes of rose associated with touches of cherry, lily as well as fine hints of pistil, fleshy plum, a racy minerality, discreet hints of bergamot, toasted and a subtle hint of sweet spices. The palate is fruity, well-balanced and offers a juicy/acidulous frame, suavity, a beautiful finesse of the grain as well as tension (full of finesse), subtlety and a good/delicate structure.

66. Gevrey-Chambertin Premier Cru, Burgundy, France Domaine Dupont-Tisserandot ,Côtes d'Or, Burgundy, France

Gevrey-Chambertin is a wine with a beautiful, bright ruby colour. Intensely fruity on the nose, the aromas are reminiscent of black cherry, wild blackberry and liquorice. The woody character is subtle and soft and marries

delicately with the other aromas. As the wine evolves, there are more complex notes, such as mild spice, nutmeg and leather.

Italy

67. Casal Thaulero Montepulciano D'abruzzo

The Montepulciano grape hails from Abruzzo in central-east Italy and produces wine full of dark sweet juicy fruit. This example from Casal Thaulero has all that fruit but with just enough tannin to make it sing with food whilst still being perfect by the glass. One of our most popular wines, a crowd-pleaser.

68. Valpolicella Superiore Ripasso Col de la Batia, Antonio

Ripasso is a somewhat esoteric method of winemaking where the Valpolicella grapes are fermented as usual but with the addition of the dried skins used for Amarone – thereby adding an extra dimension to the wine. Antonio Fattori's Col de la Bastia has a rich colour with striking morello cherry and lovely floral, red berry notes and a hint of peach kernels, so much more demonstrative than the normale – this is disgracefully drinkable with a lovely light tannic bite on the end.

69. Collezione 50 Vino Rosso, Cantina San Marzano, NV, Italy

Ruby red colour with purple reflections, intense and complex bouquet with fruity notes of prune, red jam, the spicy scent of vanilla and liquorice. Intense on the palate, full bodied and soft with a long finish.

70. Barolo, CA Bianca Tenimenti, DOCG, Italy

Savoury with leather and earthy notes, well made and stylish Barolo.

72. Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

Aromas of sweet cherry plum together with a subtle spice element. A soft, rounded mouthfeel with fruit concentration of caramel, mocha & red fruits.

74. Alan Scott, Marlborough, Pinot Noir

Ripe dark stone fruits & smoky oak with hints of liquorice & dried herbs. The plate shows delicious ripe berry fruit with bright acidity & soft tannins. If you have not tried a New Zealand pinot noir you really should.

75. Altano DOC Douro Organic Wine

The Symington Family have been wine makers for 5 generations in Portugal's Douro valley. Made with 100% organically grown grapes. Full, opulent texture with plum flavours and peppery tannins.

Black olive, blackcurrant, bramble & hints of smoked meats. Fruit driven palate yet full structured & complex.

Rendolent of raspberries, strawberries, cherries, watermelon & blackberries laced with vanilla, caramel & hazelnuts.

Hacienda de Calidad Malbec is a great value fruit-forward wine. Made with grapes harvested in the up-and-coming San Juan region this is a deep, inky violet Malbec with tempting flavours of blackberry, plum and black cherry.

#79. L.A. Cetto Petite Syrah

Aromas of sweet cherry, plum together with a subtle spice element. A soft, rounded mouthful with fruit concentration of caramel, mocha & red fruits. Thought to be grown from the original syrah vine.

Delicious sweet wine, rich and grapey with full, tropical flavours combined with freshness and elegance.

93. Saint Clair Awatere Valley Reserve Noble Riesling, Saint Clair, Marlborough Paul Cluver, South Africa

The palate has a luscious texture and notes of pear and stone fruit with a long lingering honey and lemon zesty finish.

95. Château La Tour Blanche, 1er Cru Classé Sauternes

Fresh floral bouquet on the nose accompanied by acacia, candied lemon and guava aromas. On the palate there is citrus and spices like cinnamon and capsicums. A fat and voluminous wine full of candied fruit flavours. The finish is long and intensely spicy.
